

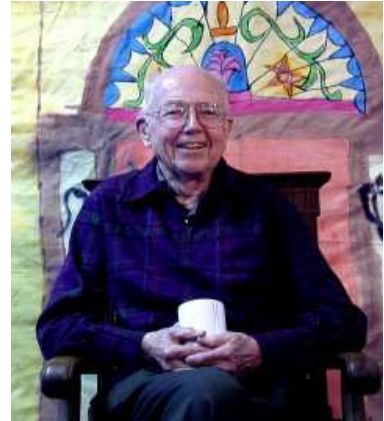

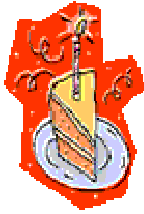

*Shepherd of the Night Flock* tells the story of **Rev. John Garcia Gensel**, who started **Jazz Vespers** in 1961 — “ a worship service by and for jazz musicians...the public is invited” at St. Peter’s Lutheran Church, at 54th and Lexington Avenue, as the



church is sold to make way for the Citicorp Center which would include a new home for the church.

It documents notable jazz performances by **Duke Ellington** and other musicians who couldn't make it on Sunday morning after playing late Saturday night gigs. Co-directed and filmed by Jim Brown, edited by Paul Barnes, who were part of an NYU student

group who put *Jazz Vespers* on Manhattan Public Access Cable three years earlier.
